

Alberta Population Projections

2011–2050
By Census Division

1. Highlights

This document presents population projections as of July 1 for Alberta and each of its 19 census divisions from 2011 to 2050, under three different sets of assumptions (i.e. low, medium and high scenarios). These projection results are available by sex and single year of age. It should be noted that population projections are not predictions. Thus, what these projections represent is a plausible evolution of the population based on the current population base and assumptions regarding the future demographic developments.

Here are some highlights of the projections.

- Alberta's population is projected to continue to grow through 2050. It is projected that there will be between 5.0 to 7.5 million Albertans by 2050. Under the medium scenario, Alberta's total population is expected to reach 6.0 million by 2050.
- The rate of population growth for each scenario is projected to remain positive but decline gradually. The average projected population growth rates range from 0.7% per year under the low-growth scenario to 1.2% and 1.8% per year under the medium and high-growth scenarios, respectively.
- In all three scenarios, future population growth is mainly driven by migration, particularly by international migration. For the period between 2010 and 2050, net migration is projected to account for 68%, or 1.6 million, of all population growth in the province under the medium-growth scenario, with natural increase accounting for the remaining 32%.
- Alberta's total fertility rate is projected to decline gradually from its high of 1.94 per woman in 2010 to 1.60 and 1.82, respectively, in the low and medium scenarios. In the high-growth scenario, total fertility rate would rise to the replacement level of 2.10 per woman by 2015 and remain at that level thereafter.
- Newborn Albertans are expected to live longer in the future. In the low and medium scenarios, the life expectancy at birth for females is projected to rise from 82.6 years in 2010 to 86.4 years in 2050, and rise from 77.8 years to 82.5 years for males. In the high scenario, females are expected to live for 89.0 years while males are expected to live for 86.2 years. As a result, the life expectancy gap between female and male is projected to narrow from 4.8 years in 2010 to 3.8 years in the low/medium scenario, and to 2.9 years in the high scenario.
- Although Alberta has one of the youngest populations in Canada, it is still aging. The median age of Alberta's population is projected to climb from 36 years in 2010 to between 40 in the high scenario and 46 in the low scenario by 2050.
- The proportion of seniors is also expected to rise as a result of the shrinking young (under 15) and working age (15–64) population. The number of people aged 65 and above would range between 1.3 and 1.6 million, or 21.6% to 26.2% of the total population in 2050, up from 396,200, or 10.6% in 2010.

- The proportion of older seniors aged 80 years and above would increase sharply in the future. By the end of the projection period, about one out of fourteen Albertans would be 80 years and over in the medium scenario, compared to one in 35 in 2010.
- Working age (15–64) Albertans are expected to account for a declining share of the total population in all scenarios. In 2010, this age group represented more than 71% of Alberta's total population. By 2050, it would fall to about 60%.
- Due to the rising number of seniors and the declining working age population, the total dependency ratio, the number of children (aged 0 to 14) and seniors (aged 65 and above) per 100 working age people (15–64), is expected to increase over the projection period. In 2050, the ratio would rise to over 65 in all scenarios, compared to 41 in 2010.
- In the medium scenario, the population in five census divisions' populations is expected to grow faster than the provincial average: CD1 (Medicine Hat), CD6 (Calgary), CD8 (Red Deer), CD16 (Wood Buffalo) and CD19 (Grande Prairie). Particularly, CD16 would lead the groups with an average annual growth rate of 2.2% between 2010 and 2050. Fourteen out of the 19 census divisions are expected to have a larger population in 2050, but CD4 (Hanna), CD7 (Stettler), CD14 (Edson), CD15 (Banff) and CD18 (Grande Cache) are projected to see their populations shrink gradually.
- All of the census divisions will shift to an older age structure. In 2010, CD16 (Wood Buffalo) had the lowest share of seniors in its population (2.1%), while CD3 (Pincher Creek) had the highest share at 17.2%. By 2050, this share is expected to increase, ranging from a low of 16.3% in CD17 (Slave Lake) to a high of 39.4% in CD15 (Banff) under the medium scenario.

2. Methodology and Assumptions

These population projections use the component method to project population growth. This method is essentially a demographic accounting system. It starts with the base-year population distributed by single year of age and sex. Then it applies fertility, mortality and migration assumptions to the base population to project the number of births, deaths, and migrants that occur during the year. Finally, these three components are either added or subtracted from the base population to obtain the population projection for the subsequent years, by age and sex.

This methodology is applied for each of the 19 census divisions in Alberta to ensure consistency and comparability. Please refer to the appendix for a complete list of these census divisions. The population projection for Alberta as a whole is generated by summing the projected populations for the 19 census divisions.

The assumptions for fertility (births), mortality (deaths), and migration are based on detailed analysis of historical trends. Three different scenarios (i.e. high, medium and low) have been prepared. The medium scenario represents the most likely case and as a result, is the reference scenario over the projection period. The high (low) scenario captures the possibility of higher (lower)-than-expected growth in certain component(s) of the population.

The base population for this projection comes from the Statistics Canada postcensal estimates of the population in Alberta as of July 1st, 2010. These estimates were based on the 2006 Census and adjusted for net undercoverage. The total population was disaggregated by sex and by single year of age up to the open age group of 90 years and over.

Note that only permanent population estimates were used for the base population. This means that while non-permanent residents and returning emigrants were included in the base, the “shadow population” or “mobile population”, was not since the primary residences for these individuals were located either outside the province of Alberta or within other census divisions. They were therefore enumerated by Statistics Canada in the Census as permanent residents of other jurisdictions.

2.1 Fertility Assumption

The fertility assumptions are developed based on the analysis of past trends. Historically, there were significant variations in the fertility rates among census divisions within the province. The potential reasons for these variations include average income levels, female educational attainment, employment opportunities for females, and the proportion of aboriginals in the overall population. The CDs have been divided into 6 groups based on similarly historical trends to develop the fertility assumptions (**Table 1**).

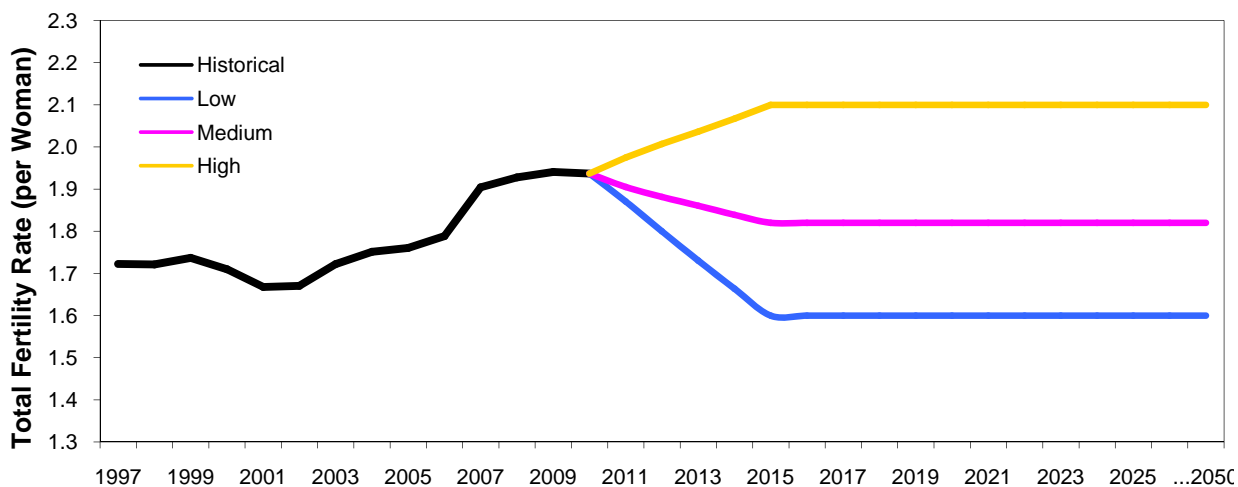

Although Alberta’s total fertility rate has been increasing in recent years, in the medium scenario it is assumed to decline gradually from 1.94 in 2010 to the 10-year average (2001–2010) of 1.82 by 2015, after which, the rate is held constant (**Figure 1**). In the low scenario, the total fertility rate is projected to fall faster than the medium case and reach 1.60 by 2015. The projected rate of 1.60 is equal to the long-term average total fertility rate (1986–2007) for Canada. In the high scenario, the total fertility rate is assumed to reach the population replacement level of 2.10 in 2015. In both scenarios, the total fertility rate is expected to remain constant after 2015.

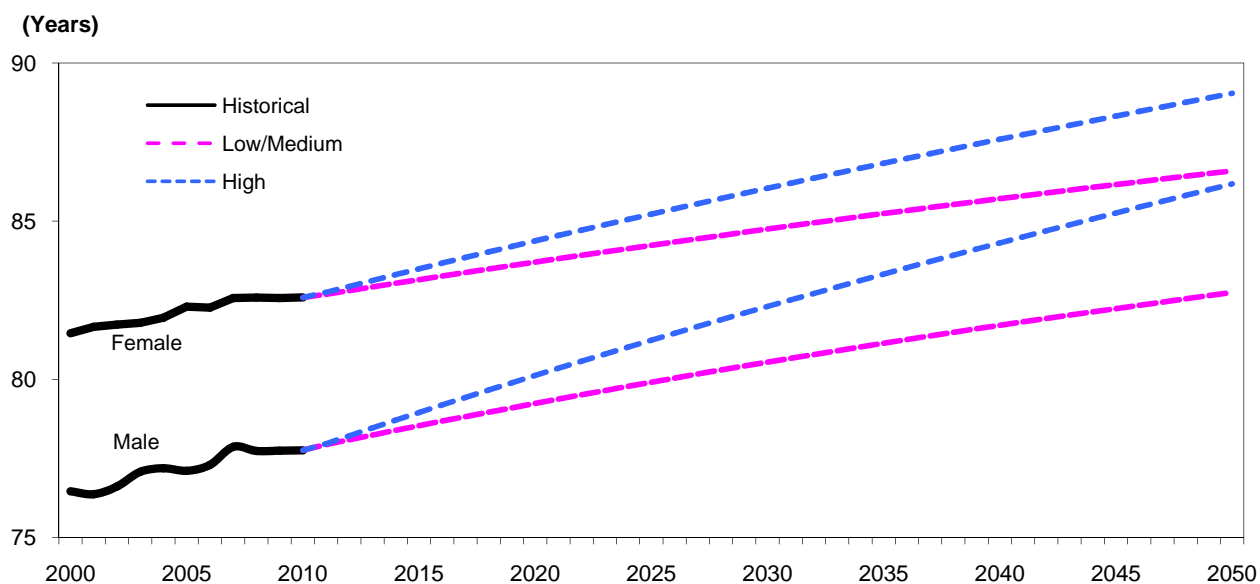
2.2 Mortality Assumption

The province has been divided into two groups to develop the mortality assumptions, major urban regions (CD6 and CD11) and rural regions (all other census divisions). The method used to project mortality is based on the Lee-Carter model (1992). This model essentially decomposes the age-specific mortality rate into three components: an age-specific constant term, a time-varying mortality index, and an age-specific component that measure how fast mortality at each age varies when the mortality index changes. Then with the projected mortality index, age-specific mortality rates can be calculated for future periods.

Two sets of mortality assumptions (low/medium and high) are developed. Under both scenarios, life expectancy at birth in Alberta is expected to continue to its upward trend in the future. Under the low/medium scenario, life expectancy at birth for females is expected to gain 3.8 years from 2010 to 86.4 by 2050, while it would increase by 4.7 years to 82.5 for males (**Figure 2**). A higher growth profile is introduced in the high scenario. Life expectancy at birth for females would reach 89.0 years in 2050 for a gain of 6.5 years; males would add 8.4 more years to their life expectancy to a total of 86.2 years by the end of the projection period.

Under both scenarios, the male life expectancy at birth is assumed to grow at a faster pace than the female life expectancy. This is consistent with overall historical trends where males have experienced larger gains than females. Therefore, the gender gap is projected to continue to shrink. In the low/medium case, this gap would fall from 4.8 years in 2010 to 3.9 years in 2050; in the high scenario, it would shrink by 41% to 2.9 years.

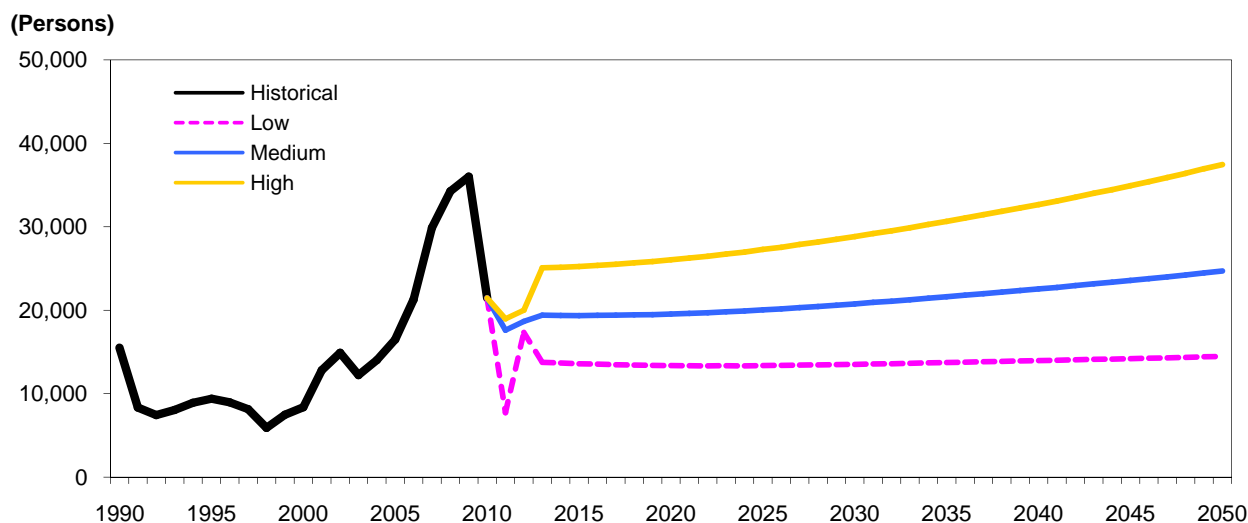
2.3 Migration Assumption

International migration is expected to continue to be driven by immigration, which is ultimately determined by federal immigration policies. Based on the historical trends, three immigration scenarios have been developed to capture the policy uncertainty. After hitting a record high of 29,961 in 2010, immigration to Alberta is expected to moderate in the near future under the medium scenario, but to resume its upward trend after 2015 and rise to 33,100 by 2050. In the high (low) scenario, immigration is projected to reach 45,900 (22,900) by the end of the projection period.

Net emigration (i.e., emigration minus returned emigrants plus net temporary emigration), is assumed to remain at its 2010 level of 8,400 over the projection period. Meanwhile, despite a few quarters of net outflows in 2009 and 2010, non-permanent residents (NPRs) to Alberta are expected to return to a more balanced condition, i.e., inflows would be completely offset by outflows.

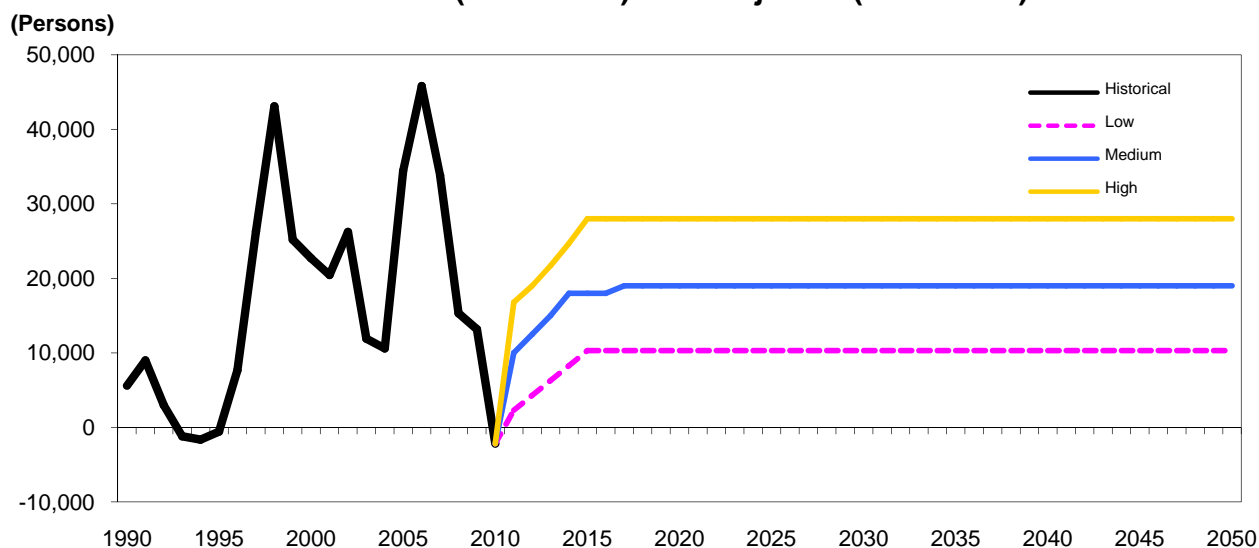
**Figure 3: Net International Migration to Alberta

Overall, net international migration to Alberta under all three scenarios is expected to drop in 2011 as a result of the further decline in net NPRs and the moderation in immigration (**Figure 3**). By 2050, Alberta is expected to gain about 14,500 net international migrants under the low scenario, and about 24,700 and 37,400, respectively, under the medium and high cases.

Net interprovincial migration is strongly driven by Alberta’s economic performance relative to other provinces. Alberta’s Budget 2011 suggests that the province will enjoy robust economic growth in the near future due to the positive outlook in the energy market and a strong household sector. As a result, net interprovincial migration to Alberta is expected to recover from the net outflow of 2,200 in 2010 to a net gain of 10,000 in 2011 under the medium case (**Figure 4**). This gain is projected to increase gradually and reach a long-term average of about 19,000 by 2017 and to remain at that level for the rest of the projection period. In the low (high) scenario, net interprovincial migration is assumed to reach 10,300 (28,000) by 2015 and remain constant afterward.

Figure 4: Net Interprovincial Migration to Alberta Historical (1990–2010) and Projected (2011–2050)

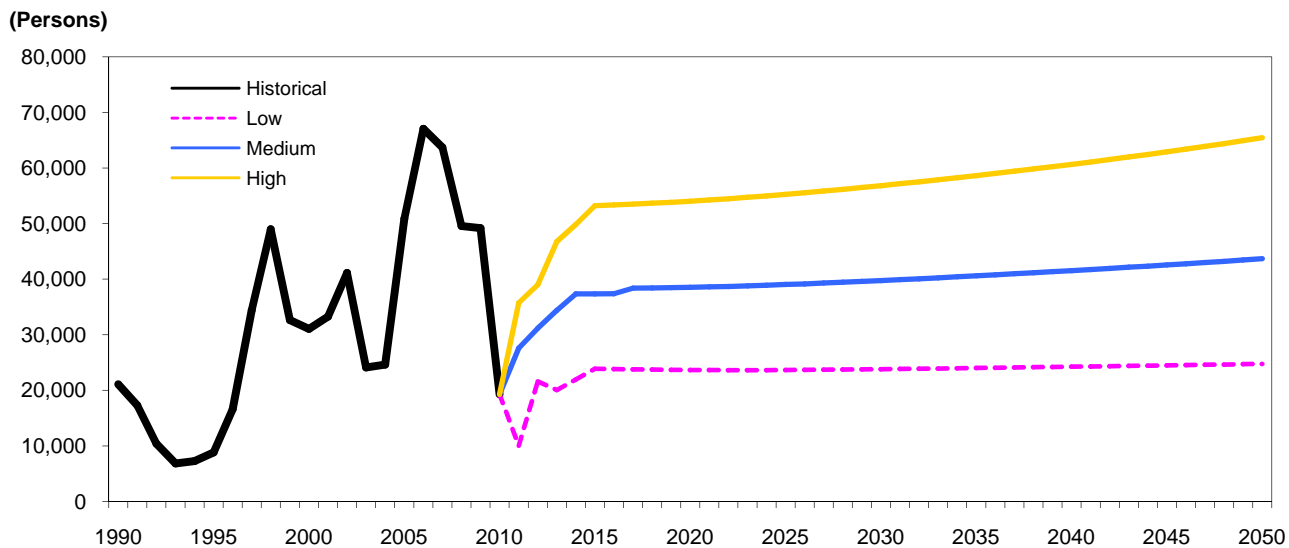

The projected number of people moving between census divisions, i.e., intraprovincial migration, is developed using the long-term average. Since intraprovincial migration has no impact on Alberta’s overall population growth, only one scenario has been developed in this projection exercise.

Combining all migration components, total net migration for Alberta is projected to rise from the dip in 2010 under the medium and high scenarios (**Figure 5**). This momentum would continue over the projection period. In the low case, total net migration is expected to fall further in 2011 because of a more pessimistic NPR assumption. However, it would resume the upward trend in 2014. The province is expected to attract about 24,800, 43,700 and 65,400 people in 2050 under the low, medium and high scenarios, respectively.

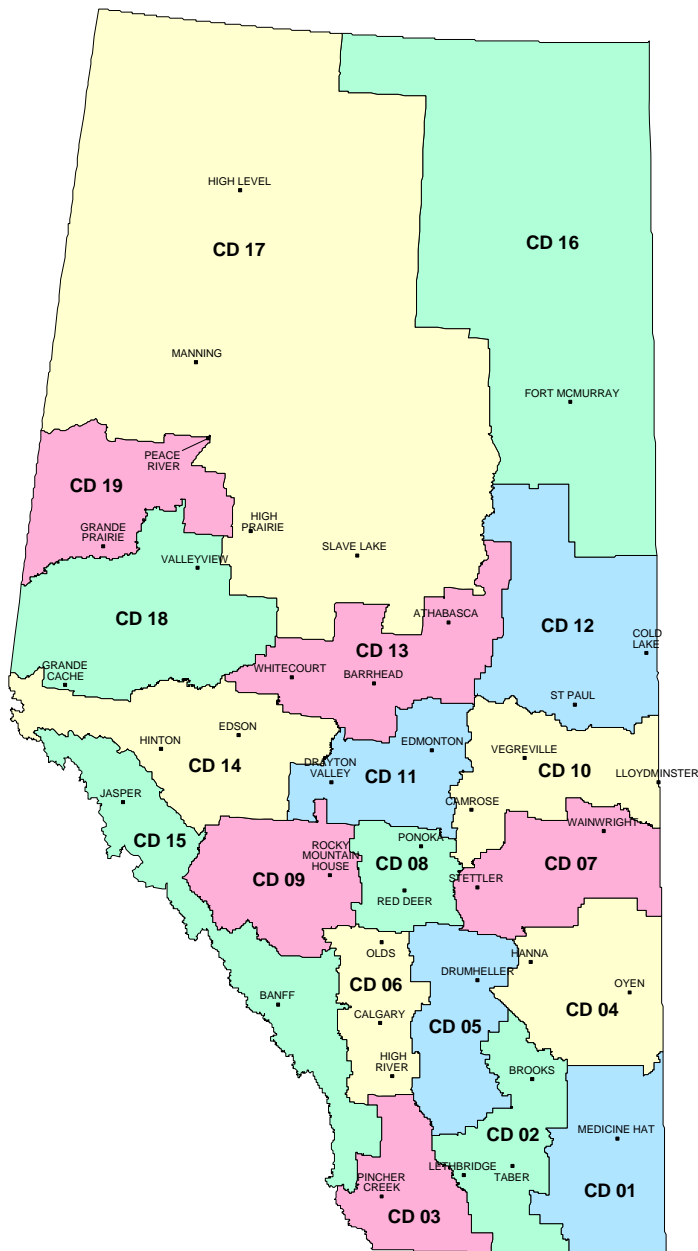
