Alberta's [Budget 2011](#) was announced on February 24. At that time, the fuel tax rebate program administered by Tax and Revenue Administration (TRA) – tax exempt fuel use (TEFU) and prescribed rebates off-road percentages (PROP) – was eliminated. To enable a smooth transition, we will continue to provide you with important information. It is important that we provide you with the information you need to comply with tax legislation and processes. To enable us to do that effectively, we survey stakeholder groups from time to time to get your perspective on complying with tax legislation.
